TECHNICAL SCHOOL GRANT PROGRAM

The Technical School Grant Program offers grants to educational institutions that are willing and able to expand their curriculum to include propane-specific material and hands-on resources. Depending on the program tier chosen, the Propane Education and Research Council (PERC) will provide up to \$10,000 in grant money to applicants. PERC will also provide the marketing and communications necessary to promote the program to potential students. Please note that funding is limited. Each school is eligible for one grant.

WHO CAN APPLY

Educational institutions and career centers (votech schools, community colleges, etc.) in the United States that are willing and able to expand their curriculum to include propane-specific material and hands-on resources for their students.

HOW IT WORKS

1. Select Tier 1 or Tier 2
2. Complete the online application
3. Submit completed documents
4. Begin instruction

CHOOSE YOUR TIER

Tier 1 : \$5,000

Tier One is for schools looking for a condensed, foundational propane systems program. Tier One applicants are required to purchase a smaller set of tools, supplies, and appliances. To qualify for Tier One, you must obtain the following propane materials for your classroom:

1. Demonstrate utilization of PERC's *Overview of Propane Distribution Systems* course.
2. A propane Regulator Test and demo training board.
3. A propane regulator cutaway.
4. Pressure measuring devices.
5. A liquid leak detector system.
6. Gas pipe, tubing and fitting samples.
7. A propane hydrometer and supply source cylinder with proper hose and fittings for liquid transfer outside of a building.
8. A propane gas appliance.

Tier 2 : \$10,000

Tier Two features the full *HVAC and Plumber Technical Training* course that is developed to support a one to two-week long curriculum to dive deeper into hands-on training. To qualify for Tier Two, you must obtain item numbers 2-7 listed in Tier One, as well as the 5 items below:

1. Demonstrate utilization of PERC's full *HVAC and Plumber Technical Training* course, including the 5 supplemental videos.
2. A natural draft propane appliance.
3. A category III propane appliance.
4. A category IV propane appliance.
5. Venting components.
